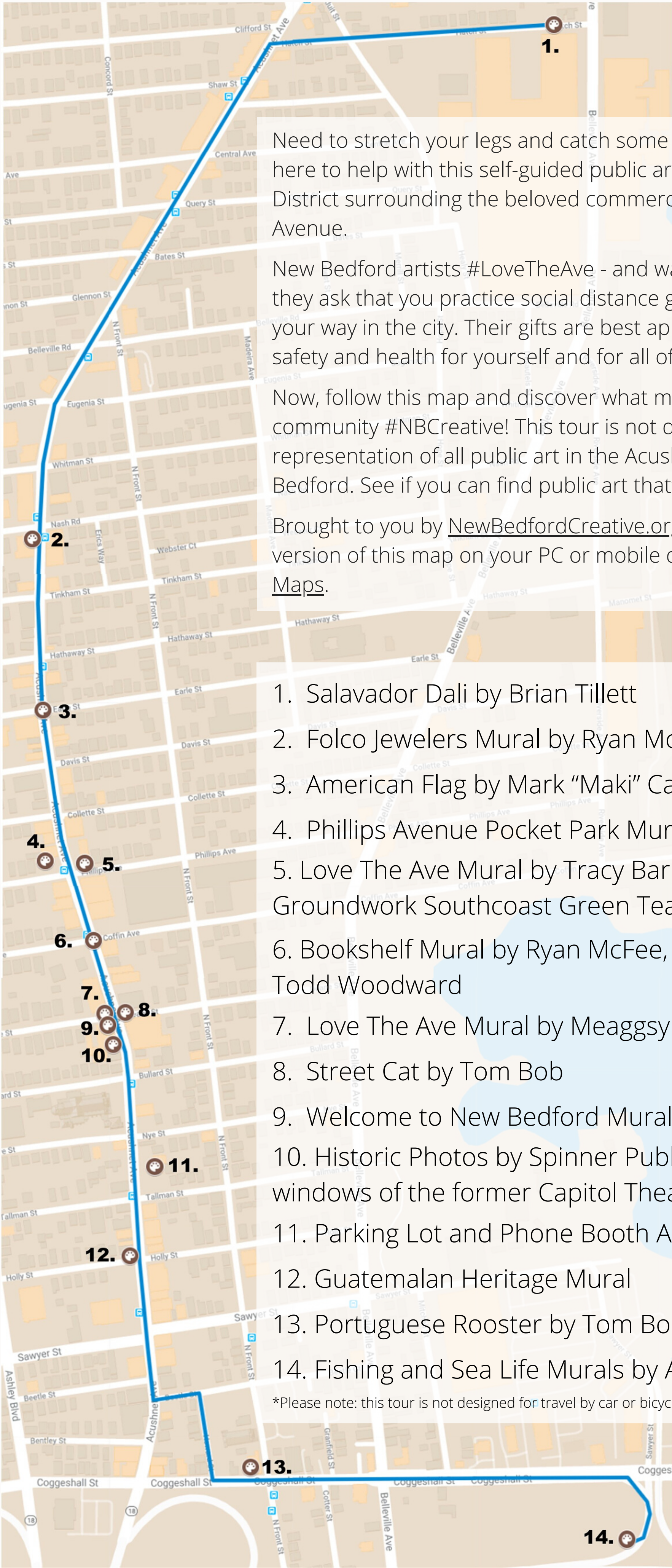


LOVE THE AVE
